CHAPTER ONE - THE IONIAN COAST

Setur Çeşme Marina (p.46)

Setur group's Çeşme Marina is located in the bay of Ilıca Koyu, and forms part of the Altın Yunus (Golden Dolphin) hotel & marina complex. There are 180 inwater berths for vessels up to 25m long (stern-to berths) and up to 45m long (side-to berths). The minimum depth in the marina is 4m. As of May 2014 the boatyard here is closed and under construction. It is expected to reopen some time in 2015.

Cesme Marina (p.49)

Construction & development of Çeşme Marina is now completed and the marina is open for business. There are 400 in-water berths, for vessels up to 60ft with 6m draft. The boatyard has space for up to 100 boats, and has an 80 ton travel lift plus a 20 ton boat mover. Technical services, including mechanical engineering, electronics, painting, varnishing & carpentry are all available on-site. There is a fuel dock located on the breakwater next to the boatyard & lifting area. Further information is available through the marina website,

Port Alaçatı Marina is located in the bay of Yumru Koyu at the northen end of the gulf of Alaçatı Körfezi. It forms a part of the Port Alacati Project, which includes the marina, plus the Port Alaçatı hotel, and a residential complex including up-market waterfront properties. The very charming town of Alaçatı is 3km away. The marina itself has 260 in-water berths for vessels up to 35m with a maximum draft of 4m. The boatyard can accommodate up to 100 boats and has a 100 ton travel lift.

D-Marin Didim Marina (p.62)

Didim Marina is part of the Turkish Doğuş Marina group, and has facilities aimed particularly at the superyachts and larger vessels that make it their home base for exploring this section of the coast. The resort town of Altınkum is located nearby, which is the location of Didim Cruise Port. The marina has 580 inwater berths (including 86 superyacht berths), and can accommodate vessels up to 70m in length and 6m draft

at stern-to berths on floating pontoons or around the marina wall. They have 70,000 sq metres of hard standing area, with 350 storage sheds to allow work to be done under cover. This is serviced by 2 travel lifts of 75 tons & 400 tons.

Located on the old site of Port Bodrum Marina in Yalıkavak, Palmarina is the project of an Azerbaijani businessman who aims to make it THE destination for superyachts, megayachts and gigayachts in Turkey. The marina has been extensively redeveloped both ashore and afloat, and is now home to designer boutiques as well as fashionably expensive bars & restaurants, and is host to prestigious events such as the Bodrum Cup, the 4th Gant Cup and others. The marina has in-water berths for 450 boats, including 69 berths for megayachts of 40m and above. Ashore there is space for 140 boats of up to 45m. The boatyard is serviced by 2 travel lifts of 100 tons & 250 tons, as well as 2 boat movers of 40 tons & 100 tons.

It is within walking distance of all the amenities of Turgutreis town and is popular with cruisers, Turkish owners and charter companies. It is also the location of an annual classical music festival (http://www.dmarinfestival.com/en-ie). There are 550 in-water berths for yachts up to 30m, either at stern-to berths with lazylines or floating finger pontoons. The hardstanding area has a travel lift of 100



tons, and a boat mover of 40 tons, and has space for around 150 yachts.

CHAPTER THREE - THE DORIAN COAST

Martı Marina (p.135)

This marina has long been a favourite choice for those who appreciate the excellent facilities that are located some distance away form the bustle of larger towns such as Bodrum & Marmaris, and offer easy access to the cruising area of the gulfs of Hisarönü Körfezi & Yeşilova Körfezi. The long-stalled development of the marina hotel has finally been completed, and the luxurious Hemithea boutique hotel is now open in the hillsides surrounding the marina (http://martihemitheahotel.com/home).

Martı Marina has 380 in-water berths with a maximum draft of 20m. Lazyline berths can accommodate yachts

up to 50m, but larger yachts up to 100m are able to moor using their own anchor. Ashore there is hardstanding area for up to 100 vessels, and the marina has a 60 ton travel lift. As of May 2014 the marina has applied to be recognised as a port of entry, but as this permission has not been granted yet all entry & exit facilities must be completed at the nearby ports of Datça, Bozburun or Marmaris, although the marina can assist with other formalities such as transit log renewals.

Albatros Marina is a small private marina in Marmaris bay, that is primarily home to the Offshore Sailing charter company, but also welcomes private yachts. It has space for around 44 yachts in the water, and a boatyard capacity of around 150 yachts. The yard operates 2 lifts of 20 tons and 100 tons, and also has slipways capable of hauling vessels up to 300 tons.



The marina is in a peaceful location midway between Marmaris Netsel Marina and Marmaris Yacht Marina, and is a short dolmuş ride from Marmaris centre. The marina does have plans to expand and house up to another 250 boats, but development work has not started and is not scheduled to do so any time soon.

Marmaris Yacht Marina (p.163)

Marmaris Yacht Marina is located on the narrow strip of land that connects Yildiz Adasi to the mainland, in what is known as Yalancı Boğaz (False or Liar's channel) because although it appears navigable from a distance, in fact it is crossed by a narrow bar that prevents passage. Yacht Marina is one of the largest marinas in Turkey, with 650 in-water berths and an enormous yard that can accommodate over 1,000 boats. The marina operates 3 travel lifts of 50, 70 and 330 tons, and there are several large hangars where work can be carried out under cover. A dolmuş service runs into town every 20-30 minutes throughout the year, and there are plenty of facilities available on-site, which means that it is not necessary to make the trip every day. This is a very popular spot for liveaboard cruisers during the winter, and there is a full calendar of events organised to pass the colder months.

CHAPTER FOUR - THE LYCIAN COAST

D-Marin Göcek Marina (p.180)

The Doğuş Marina group has now acquired what used to be the Port Göcek Marina and is now Göcek D-Marin on the eastern side of the village. The marina

layout is basically unchanged, with protected in-water berthing for 380 vessels up to 80m in length. Their hardstanding area is still on the opposite side of the bay next to the Marinturk Village Port facility, and has space for 150 yachts with a 70 ton travel lift. D-Marina is one of the few marinas in Göcek where vessels can remain in the water year-round.

Marinturk Village Port (p.180)

The Marinturk Village Port Marina is located right in the middle of Göcek bay and has become a popular base for charter yacht companies as well as visiting private and cruising yachts. The Marina can now accommodate up to 215 yachts on its floating jetties, but these are closed during the winter months (November – April) because of a lack of protection from wind & waves coming from the south. The marina also has a hardstanding area that can accommodate around 200 boats, and operates a 75 ton travel lift, a 200 ton travel lift & a 40 ton boat mover. Work has recently resumed on the stalled development of the Rixos hotel & villa accommodation next to the marina. The Marinturk Exclusive Marina is designed to cater for superyachts and megayachts of 18m and above, and is located slightly further west from the Village Port in the bay of Poruklu Koyu. Two floating docks



extend either side of one of the only swimming beaches in Göcek bay (the other is just east of D-Marina and is also a private facility). The docks are fully shaded along their entire length, and can accommodate up to 100 vessels. There is a courtesy service to Göcek village, and all maintenance & yard work can be organised through the Village Port office.

Göcek Club Marina is well established in the western end of Göcek Bay and surrounded by pine forest. This sheltered location means that vessels can stay in the water all year round on floating pontoons or concrete jetties. The marina has 225 berths, and can accept vessels up to 95m long and with 7m draft. The marina does not have any boatyard facilities of its own, so haul outs and maintenance work must be organised with external contractors and through other yards in the area. During the summer months the marina operates a courtesy boat service between Club Marina and its sister organization Skopea Marina located in the centre of Göcek village. Timetables are posted at both marinas.

Part of the Setur Marinas group, Kaş Marina opened for business in 2010 and is located in the Bucak Denizi bay immediately to the west of Kaş Limanı. The marina is a 10 minute walk from Kaş town, and there are dolmuş buses running approximately every 15 minutes. The marina has 7 floating pontoons protected by a breakwater, and a hardstanding area at the furthest end of the bay. Berthing is stern-to with lazylines on



the pontoons, which can accommodate 472 vessels up to 150m with up to 10m draft. The hardstanding area has room for 160 boats and the marina operates a 100 ton travel lift & 45 ton boat moving trailer.

VISAS & RESIDENCE PERMITS

The E-Visa System for Visiting tourists is fully up and running and is the preferred form of visa for short term visitors to Turkey.

The Visa is valid for 180 days from the date of issue, and entitles the holder to spend up to 90 days in Turkey during that period, with multiple entries permitted.

A new E-Visa cannot be obtained until 180 days has passed since the previous E-Visa was issued.

Penalties will be applied if you remain longer than the permitted 90 days in a 180 day period, including fines based on the length of overstay, and a possible ban on returning to Turkey within a given period.

E-Visas should be purchased in advance through the website: https://www.evisa.gov.tr/en/ You will need access to a printer in order to print your E-Visa, which you must have with you when you enter the country.

If you wish to stay in Turkey for longer than 90 out of 180 days then you must obtain a Residence Permit. The system for obtaining these permits has been overhauled and the procedure is now managed by the newly established Directorate General of Migration



Management. Applications must be made online through this website, which is available in Turkish and English: https://e-ikamet.goc.gov.tr/

You will need to be able to upload a standard ID-appropriate photo of yourself, as well as complete the other details requested. When your application is completed you will be given an appointment at the closest Directorate office, where you will need to supply your supporting documents and proof of payment for the permit.

The online application form must be completed before your current visa or residence permit expires. You will have to collect your residence permit from the same office where the application was made, and you will be advised when it is ready to collect by phone or email, so you must arrange your cruising schedule around this.
