VISAS & RESIDENCE PERMITS

The E-Visa System for Visiting tourists is fully up and running and is the preferred form of visa for short term visitors to Turkey.

The Visa is valid for 180 days from the date of issue, and entitles the holder to spend up to 90 days in Turkey during that period, with multiple entries permitted.

A new E-Visa cannot be obtained until 180 days has passed since the previous E-Visa was issued.

Penalties will be applied if you remain longer than the permitted 90 days in a 180 day period, including fines based on the length of overstay, and a possible ban on returning to Turkey within a given period.

E-Visas should be purchased in advance through the website: <https://www.evisa.gov.tr/en/> You will need access to a printer in order to print your E-Visa, which you must have with you when you enter the country.

If you wish to stay in Turkey for longer than 90 out of 180 days then you must obtain a Residence Permit. The system for obtaining these permits has been overhauled and the procedure is now managed by the newly established Directorate General of Migration Management. Applications must be made online through this website, which is available in Turkish and English: <https://e-ikamet.goc.gov.tr/>

You will need to be able to upload a standard ID-appropriate photo of yourself, as well as complete the other details requested. When your application is completed you will be given an appointment at the closest Directorate office, where you will need to supply your supporting documents and proof of payment for the permit.

The online application form must be completed before your current visa or residence permit expires. You will have to collect your residence permit from the same office where the application was made, and you will be advised when it is ready to collect by phone or email, so you must arrange your cruising schedule around this.

NEW MARINAS

There are a number of new marinas in development or due to open soon along the Turkish coast. Where available details are shown below.

Port Iasos Marina - 37°14'.94N 27°32'.14E

Port Iasos Marina opened in 2013 and is located directly opposite the town of Güllük on the other side of Güllük Körfezi. The marina has in-water berths for 150 vessel up to 30m. Technical services are available on site, but the marina currently has no hard-standing facilities.

Marmaris Club Marina - 35°49'.08N 28°17'.35E
Marmaris Club Marina is a new development that will open in June 2015. Located on Sehir Adasi in Marmaris Bay it has in-water berths for 120 vessels and will also have a hard-standing area for up to 100 vessels. The yard has a 75-ton travel lift and 40-ton boat transporter. There is road access to Marmaris Town from the marina, and they also plan to run a ferry across the bay twice a day.

Levent is a small city marina located on the southern side of İzmir Körfezi as you approach the city. The marina and buildings have recently been renovated and opened up as a private marina catering for boats up to 25m long. A full range of technical services is available and there is a hard-standing area with a 200-ton travel lift. Fuel can be arranged by tanker and the marina office can organise customs and transit log formalities on request.
