Chapter 3 ORFORD RIVER pp 28, 29, 30 and 34 The Entrance

Based on a survey carried out by Trinity House in February 2023, the seasonal entrance buoys have been laid in the following positions (liable to change):

Orford Haven SWM 52° 02'.00N 01°28'.20E

Oxley (port-hand) 52° 02'.02N 01° 27'.10E

Weir (stbd-hand) 52° 02'.24N 01° 27'.60E

Chapter 5 THE RIVER DEBEN pp. 43, 44, 45 and 46 The Entrance

SINCE LAST YEAR THERE HAS BEEN A MAJOR CHANGE

Instead of entering along the Felixstowe shore inside The Knolls shoals, the newly-buoyed entrance route is now further north and runs between The Knolls. A course from near the Mid Knoll starboard-hand buoy, heading towards Martello Tower U, takes you past West Knoll port-hand buoy to enter the river between Knoll Spit port-hand buoy and Deben starboard-hand buoy.

The entrance has now returned nearer to how it was before the leading marks (or metes) on the shore were finally removed in 2000. By that time the entrance had moved so much further south that the single Bar buoy and leading marks were no longer helpful, therefore in the following years new buoyage was incorporated.
